

# OZ McGuire

Born in Kansas City, MO., Oz McGuire, adjunct printmaking professor at KCAI, studied fine art at the University of Kansas and Staffordshire University in Stoke-on-Trent, England. His video work has been displayed in group shows in St. Louis, Chicago and New York.

Recently he was chosen as a Kansas City Avenue of the Arts 2005 recipient, creating a lightbox entitled "PR Memorial (That Lynch Movie)," which featured still imagery appropriated from made-for-television movies, a recurring theme of his video work.

McGuire's work as a disk jockey, specifically experimenting with the ideas of the remix and dub culture, influence and integrate into his visual output. At KCAI, McGuire teaches "Consumption of Media," a printmaking elective designed for the "expanded" field of print.
